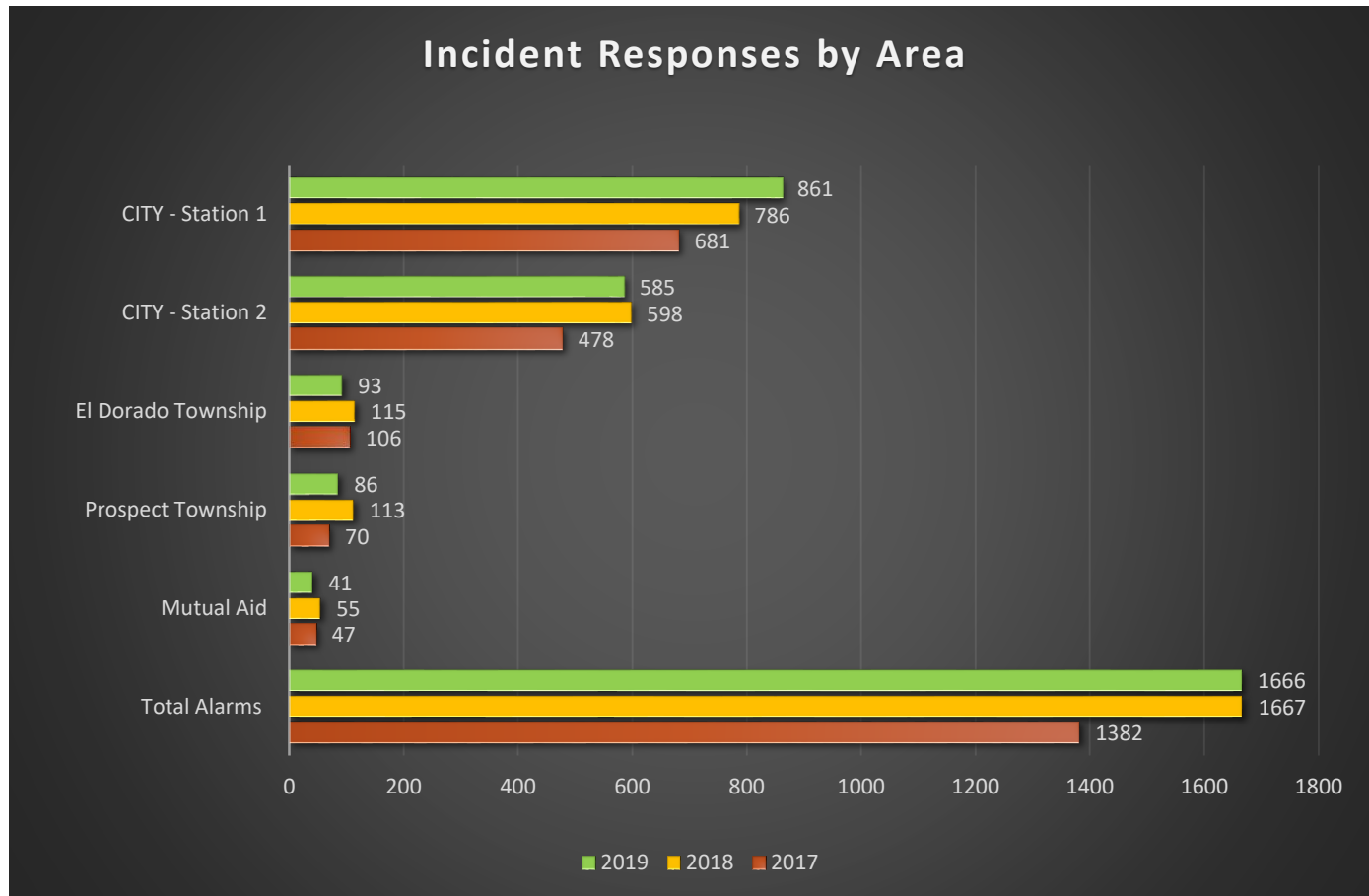

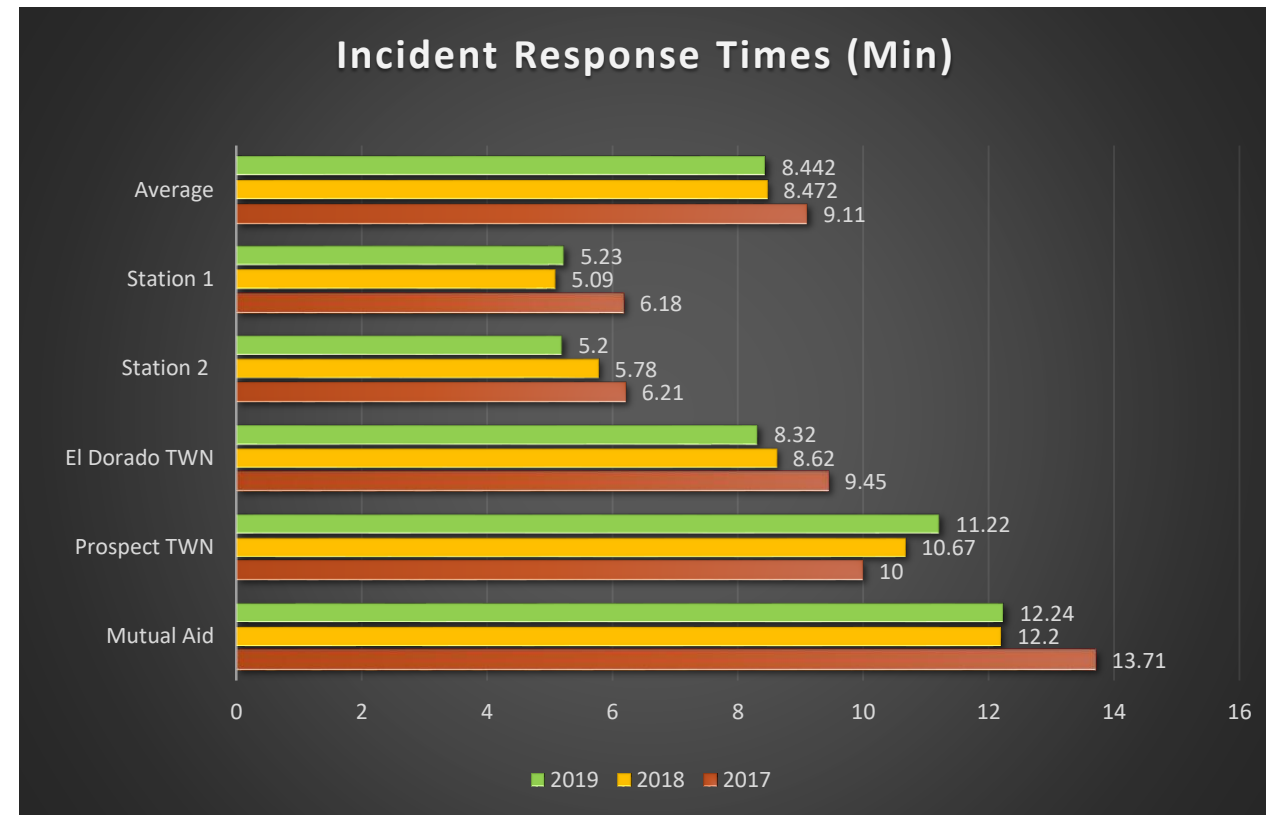

- Mutual Aid - 12.24 minutes (Up 0.04)

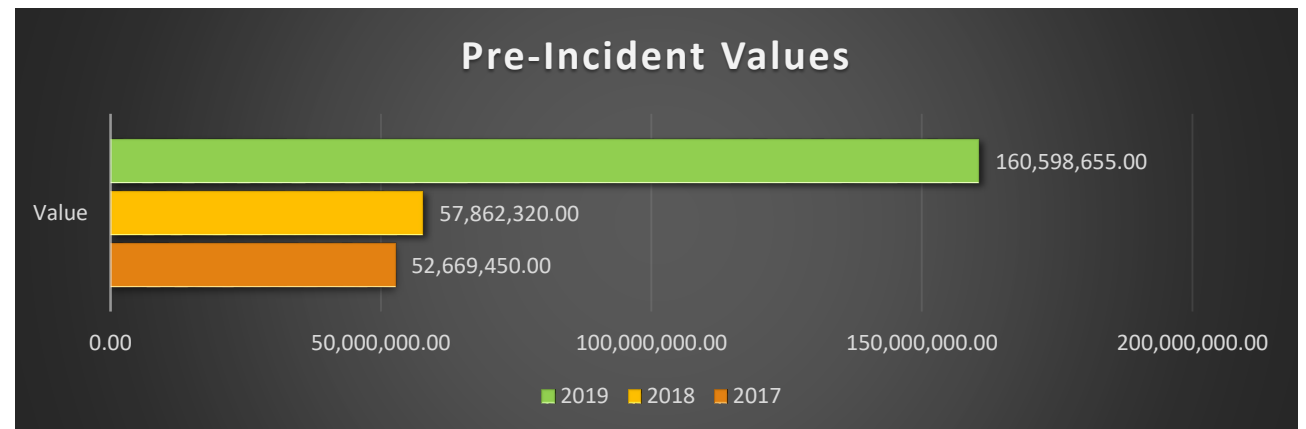
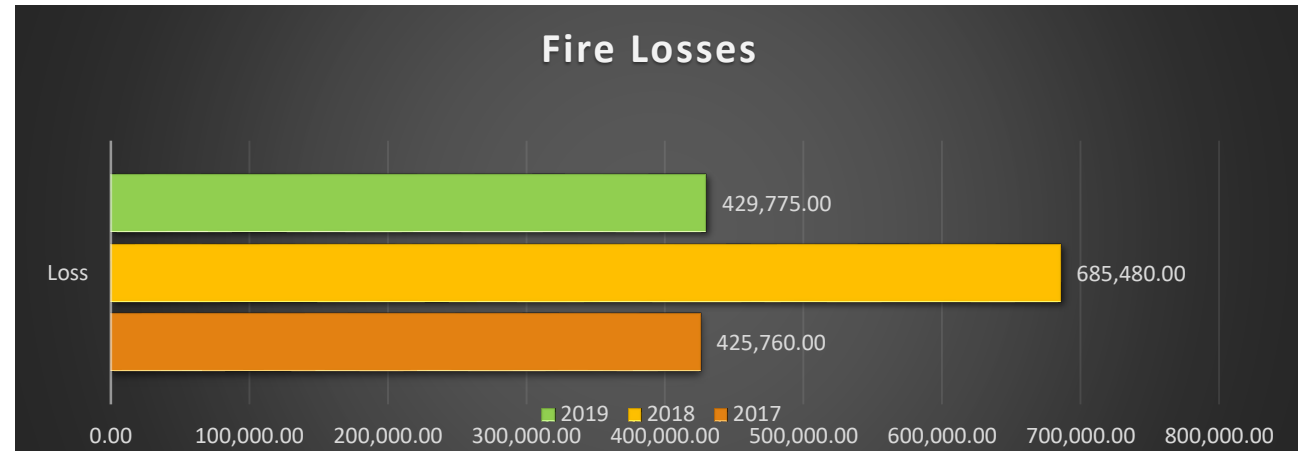
